

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Approving FY 2022 Planning and Economic Development Department  
Roads Program Road Safety Assessment BIA Route 19 Budget)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 21-333**

1 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds  
2 within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to appropriate  
3 these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll  
4 expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"  
5 authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham  
6 Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and

7 **WHEREAS,** the Planning and Economic Development Department has prepared and  
8 submitted for review and approval its FY 2022 Roads Program Road Safety  
9 Assessment BIA Route 19 Budget, which is incorporated by this reference, in the  
10 amount of \$99,974.46 to be funded from the Nation's general fund pending  
11 reimbursement from the grantor, the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and

12 **WHEREAS,** the Agricultural and Natural Resources and Budget and Finance Committees  
13 have reviewed the FY 2022 Planning and Economic Development Department  
14 Roads Program Road Safety Assessment BIA Route 19 Budget and recommend its  
15 approval.

16 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the  
17 **FY 2022 Planning and Economic Development Department Roads Program Road**  
18 **Safety Assessment BIA Route 19 Budget effective October 1, 2021 in the amount of**  
19 **\$99,974.46, which shall be funded by the Nation's general fund pending**  
20 **reimbursement from the grantor, the Bureau of Indian Affairs.**

21 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham  
22 Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to administer and  
23 expend the FY 2022 Planning and Economic Development Department Roads  
24 Program Road Safety Assessment BIA Route 19 Budget, provided that any  
25 amendments or modifications shall be submitted for prior approval by the  
26 Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.

27 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 08<sup>TH</sup>**  
28 **day of SEPTEMBER, 2021 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,218.0 FOR;**  
29 **-0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and -0- ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**  
30 **Article VI, Section 1(d)(2) and (3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by**  
31 **the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**  
32 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**  
33 **18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**
