

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Accepting a P.L. 93-638 Grant to Receive Highway Infrastructure Program –  
Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act Funds  
for Preventative and/or Routine Maintenance of BIA Roads)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 21-336**

1 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is vested with the authority to “consult,  
2 negotiate and conclude agreements and contracts on behalf of the Tohono  
3 O'odham Nation with Federal, State and local governments and other Indian  
4 tribes or their departments, agencies, or political subdivisions, or with private  
5 persons or organizations on all matters within the authority of the Tohono  
6 O'odham Council” (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, Article VI,  
7 Section 1(f)); and

8 **WHEREAS,** the U.S. Bureau of Indian Affairs (“BIA”) Western Regional Office has notified the  
9 Tohono O'odham Nation (“Nation”) that it is eligible to receive \$765,183.59, which  
10 will be made available pursuant to P.L. 116-260, the Highway Infrastructure  
11 Program – Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act  
12 (“HIP-CRRSAA Funds”) of 2021 for Fiscal Year 2022; and

13 **WHEREAS,** the Nation would like to accept the HIP-CRRSAA Funds through a P.L. 93-638 Grant  
14 and will use the entire amount of \$765,183.59 for preventative and/or routine  
15 maintenance of BIA Roads located within the exterior boundaries of the Nation's  
16 reservation; and

17 **WHEREAS,** the Nation will need to separately track and report on all HIP-CRRSAA Funds  
18 expended pursuant to the requirements of 23 U.S.C. 201(c)(6)(c) and the Nation's  
19 Tribal Transportation Plan; and

20 **WHEREAS,** the Agricultural and Natural Resources and Budget and Finance Committees  
21 have reviewed the HIP-CRRSAA Funds proposal and recommend acceptance.

22 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council accepts a P.L.  
23 93-638 Grant from the U.S. Bureau of Indian Affairs in the amount of \$765,183.59,  
24 made available pursuant to P.L. 116-260, the Highway Infrastructure Program –  
25 Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act of 2021 for  
26 Fiscal Year 2022, which will be used entirely for preventative and/or routine  
27 maintenance of BIA Roads located within the exterior boundaries of the Nation's  
28 reservation.

29 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council authorizes the Nation's  
30 chairperson or official designee to sign and execute any and all documents  
31 related to the P.L. 93-638 Grant made available to the Nation pursuant to P.L. 116-




