9		impact upon Congressional appropriations and IHS allocation of funds; and						
10	WHEREAS,	the Indian Health Service has provided a Tribal Priority ranking of the three most						
11	critical projects and allocated points, which impacts the overall prioritization of							
12		projects; and						
13	WHEREAS, the Division of Environmental Health and Engineering has provided the							
14	recommendations to the Health and Human Services Committee regarding the							
15		most critical needs; and						
16	WHEREAS,	WHEREAS, the Health and Human Services Committee has reviewed and recommends						
17		approval of the three most critical and desirable priorities.						
18	NOW, THERE	FORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council has reviewed

20	deficiencies are the three most critical and desirable, in descending order of

23		2. Chui Chu - Water Storage Tank
