

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY 2022 Baboquivari District Budgets)**

RESOLUTION NO. 21-366

1 **WHEREAS,** pursuant to Article IX, Section 7 of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham
2 Nation,
3 No district council shall expend district funds except pursuant to budgets
4 authorized under resolutions of the district council and approved by the Tohono
5 O'odham Council. The management of these funds shall be only by a treasurer or
6 other authorized officer of the district council who has furnished a surety bond
7 satisfactory to the treasurer of the Tohono O'odham Nation, and all expenditures
8 of these funds shall be by checks signed by such treasurer or other authorized
9 officer and the chairman or vice chairman of the district council.

11 **WHEREAS,** by Baboquivari District Council Resolution No. 2021-B-104, the Baboquivari
12 District has authorized the FY 2022 Baboquivari District Administration and
13 Community Budgets and the FY 2022 Artesia/Little Tucson Community Building
14 Project Budget, which are incorporated by these references, in the total amount
15 of \$5,193,817.36 (collectively, the "FY 2022 Baboquivari District Budgets"); and

16 **WHEREAS,** the Budget and Finance Committee has reviewed the FY 2022 Baboquivari District
17 Budgets and recommends approval.

18 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves:

- 19 (1) the FY 2022 Baboquivari District Administration and Community Budgets
20 effective October 1, 2021 in the amount of \$4,288,132.28, which shall be
21 funded by the August 2021 District Gaming Allocation; and
22 (2) the FY 2022 Artesia/Little Tucson Community Building Project Budget
23 effective October 1, 2021 in the amount of \$905,685.08, which shall be
24 funded by the FY 2021 Artesia/Little Tucson Community Building Project
25 Budget carry forward funds.

26 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the FY 2022
27 Baboquivari District Budgets shall be managed and expended in accordance with
28 Article IX, Section 7 of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation and the
29 Nation's laws, provided that any amendments or modifications shall be
30 authorized under District Council resolution and submitted for prior approval by
31 the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 22ND day of SEPTEMBER, 2021 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,218.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and -0- ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by, Article IX, Section 7 of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
