12		("BIA"), effective October 1, 2019 through September 30, 2022; and
13	WHEREAS,	the Planning and Economic Development Department has prepared and
14		submitted for review and approval its FY 2022 BIA Allocated School Bus Road
15		Maintenance Project Budget, which is incorporated by this reference, in the
16		amount of \$61,227.69; and
17	WHEREAS,	the Agricultural and Natural Resources and Budget and Finance Committees
18		have reviewed the Bureau of Indian Affairs Grant Award and the FY 2022 BIA
19		Allocated School Bus Road Maintenance Project Budget and recommend
20		approval.
21	NOW, THERE	FORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council accepts the
22		Bureau of Indian Affairs Grant Award in the amount of \$61,227.69, effective

25		\$61,227.69 effective October 1, 2021, that shall be funded by the Nation's general
26		fund pending reimbursement from the grantor, the Bureau of Indian Affairs.
