11	WHEREAS,	the FY 2021 Radio Use Agreement will allow Drexel Heights Fire District to act as a
12	,	billing administrator for the Nation's use of PCWIN radio equipment in San

14	WHEREAS,	the Agreement requires a partial waive of sovereign immunity to allow for
