## RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL (Repealing Resolution No. 20-121 "Suspending Timeframes in the Appointed Officers Law Due to the COVID-19 Pandemic")

**RESOLUTION NO. 21-427** 

1	WHEREAS,	the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation vests the Nation's chairman with
2		the authority to appoint the Nation's treasurer, and other officers and heads of all
3		governmental departments with the approval of the Tohono O'odham Legislative
4		Council (Constitution, Article VII, Section 2(e)); and
5	WHEREAS,	the Nation's Appointed Officers law provides the process for review and
6		consideration of the Nation's Chairman's appointments for treasurer, and other
7		officers and heads of all governmental departments officers, including different
8		timeframes for oversight committee and Council review (1 Tohono O'odham Code
9		Chapter 4); and
10	WHEREAS,	pursuant to Section 4003(B) of the Appointed Officers law, the appropriate
11		legislative oversight committee shall be provided with the current job
12		description for the appointed officer's position, and the appointee's current
13		resume, contact information, and a written background investigation report
14		completed within 30 days of submission to the committee" (1 Tohono O'odham
15		Code Chapter 4); and
16	WHEREAS,	on June 14, 2019, the Legislative Council considered and approved Chairman
17		Norris' appointed officers for the following departments: Water Resources,
18		Education, Health and Human Services, Public Safety, Treasury, Tohono
19		O'odham Gaming Office, and Chief Administrative Officer; and
20	WHEREAS,	on March 13, 2020, the Nation's Chairman, in response to the rapid spread of
21		COVID-19 in the United States and confirmed presences in the State of Arizona,
22		declared a State of Emergency for the Tohono O'odham Nation and established
23		the Nation's Unified Command to coordinate necessary policies and to direct
24		resources; and
25	WHEREAS,	by Resolution No. 20-094, the Legislative Council authorized the Nation's
26		Chairman and Vice-Chairwoman to prepare, mitigate, prevent, respond, and
27		recover from the COVID-19 pandemic by taking a number of authorized actions;
28		and
29	WHEREAS,	by Resolution No. 20-121, in response to the Rules Committee's recommendation
30		and based upon the closure of the Legislative Branch offices and pause of in-
31		person meetings, the Legislative Council suspended all time periods prescribed
32		in the Appointed Officers law for appointed officer appointees until 30 days after

3	WHEREAS,	although the Legislative Branch offices have been closed since March 19, 2020,
4		the Legislative Council committees have continued to meet virtually for regular
5		committee meetings and the Legislative Council has continued to conduct official
6		business during general, special, and emergency sessions using virtual meeting
7		technology; and
8	WHEREAS,	individuals have been serving as appointed officers for the following
9		departments for more than 120 days without approval of their appointments by
10		the Legislative Council: Membership Services, Department of Natural Resources,
11		and Department of Planning and Economic Development; and
12	WHEREAS,	the Rules Committee recommends repealing Resolution No. 20-121 to allow for
13		the five remaining appointed officers appointments to move forward to the
14		Legislative Council with some modifications to the Nation's Appointed Officer law
15		to allow flexibility in response to the continued office closure and to adhere to
16		public health measures.
17	NOW, THER	EFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council repeals
18		Resolution No. 20-121 on the effective date of this resolution.
19	BE IT FURT	HER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council, notwithstanding 1
20		Tohono O'odham Code Chapter 4, authorizes:
21		1. an appointee who has undergone the Appointed Officers process pursuant to
22		Section 4003(B) and (C) to proceed to the Legislative Council, provided that the
23		background investigation report shall be updated and reviewed by the
24		respective oversight committee prior to the appointee's interview with the
25		Legislative Council;
26		2. the start of the process of review and consideration pursuant to the Appointed
27		Officers law by the appropriate oversight committee regardless of the status
28		of the Legislative Branch offices closure, provided that a background
29		investigation report shall be considered valid for 90 days after it is completed;
30		3. elimination of the in-person interview requirement in the Appointed Officers
31		law to allow virtual committee and Legislative Council interviews.
32	BE IT FURT	HER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council, notwithstanding 1 Tohono O'odham Code Chapter 4, requires all appointees who have served more
33		than 180 days prior to the enactment of this resolution undergo the committee
