

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY 2022 Planning and Economic Development Department Roads Program
PIR Consolidated No. 28 Sells Street Signs and Warning Lights Project Budget)

RESOLUTION NO. 21-430

1 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds
2 within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to appropriate
3 these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll
4 expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"
5 authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham
6 Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and

7 **WHEREAS,** by Resolution No. 16-342, the Legislative Council approved the FY 2017 Planning
8 and Economic Development Department, Roads Program Sells District Signs and
9 Warning Lights Budget in the amount of \$147,237.80 funded by the Nation's
10 general fund pending reimbursement by the grantor, the Bureau of Indian
11 Affairs; and

12 **WHEREAS,** the Bureau of Indian Affairs Western Region Office awarded the Nation a no-cost
13 extension for the assessment, installation of PIR Consolidated No. 28 Sells Street
14 Signs and Warning Lights Project to September 30, 2023; and

15 **WHEREAS,** the Planning and Economic Development Department has prepared and
16 submitted for review and approval its FY 2022 Roads Program PIR Consolidated
17 No. 28 Sells Street Signs and Warning Lights Project Budget, which is incorporated
18 by this reference, in the amount of \$139,859.76; and

19 **WHEREAS,** the Agricultural and Natural Resources and Budget and Finance Committees
20 have reviewed the FY 2022 Planning and Economic Development Department
21 Roads Program PIR Consolidated No. 28 Sells Street Signs and Warning Lights
22 Project Budget and recommend its approval.

23 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the
24 **FY 2022 Planning and Economic Development Department Roads Program PIR**
25 **Consolidated No. 28 Sells Street Signs and Warning Lights Project Budget effective**
26 **October 1, 2021 through September 30, 2023 in the amount of \$139,859.76, which**
27 **shall be funded by the Nation's general fund pending reimbursement by the**
28 **grantor, the Bureau of Indian Affairs as referenced in BIAWRO Master Contract**
29 **A10AV00192.**

30 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham
31 **Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to administer and**
32 **expend FY 2022 Planning and Economic Development Department Roads**
