

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY 2022 Planning and Economic Development Department Roads
Program Project PIR 10(1) Fresno Canyon Bridge No. 662 Budget)**

RESOLUTION NO. 21-431

1 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds
2 within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to appropriate
3 these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll
4 expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"
5 authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham
6 Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and

7 **WHEREAS,** the Bureau of Indian Affairs Western Region Office approved and awarded a no-
8 cost extension for the engineering studies and investigations required to
9 determine the feasibility of Project PIR 10(1) Fresno Canyon Bridge No. 662 to
10 September 30, 2023; and

11 **WHEREAS,** the Planning and Economic Development Department has prepared and
12 submitted for review and approval its FY 2022 Roads Program Project PIR 10(1)
13 Fresno Canyon Bridge No. 662 Budget, which is incorporated by this reference in
14 the amount of \$90,000.00 to be funded by the Nation's general fund pending
15 reimbursement by the grantor, the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and

16 **WHEREAS,** the Agricultural and Natural Resources and Budget and Finance Committees
17 have reviewed the FY 2022 Planning and Economic Development Department
18 Roads Program Project PIR 10(1) Fresno Canyon Bridge No. 662 Budget and
19 recommend its approval.

20 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the
21 FY 2022 Planning and Economic Development Department Roads Program
22 Project PIR 10(1) Fresno Canyon Bridge No. 662 Budget effective October 1, 2021
23 in the amount of \$90,000.00, which shall be funded by the Nation's general fund
24 pending reimbursement by the grantor, the Bureau of Indian Affairs as
25 referenced in BIAWRO Master Contract A15AV00903.

26 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham
27 Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to administer and
28 expend the FY 2022 Planning and Economic Development Department Roads
29 Program Project PIR 10(1) Fresno Canyon Bridge No. 662 Budget, provided that
30 any amendments or modifications shall be submitted for prior approval by the
31 Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.


