

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY 2022 Professional Services Agreement between the Tohono
O'odham Nation and Intermountain Centers for Human Development, Inc.)**

RESOLUTION NO. 21-432

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to consult, negotiate and**
2 **conclude agreements and contracts on behalf of the Tohono O'odham Nation**
3 **with Federal, State and local governments and other Indian tribes or their**
4 **departments, agencies, or political subdivisions, or with private persons or**
5 **organizations on all matters within the authority of the Tohono O'odham**
6 **Council." (Constitution, Article VI, Section 1(f)); and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Professional Services Agreement between the Tohono O'odham Nation**
8 **("Nation") and Intermountain Centers for Human Development, Inc.**
9 **("Intermountain") will allow Intermountain to provide residential and foster**
10 **care services for the Nation's Children In Need of Care for the period of October 1,**
11 **2021 to September 30, 2022; and**

12 **WHEREAS, the Professional Services Agreement is in excess of \$500,000.00, and therefore**
13 **requires Legislative Council approval, pursuant to 26 Tohono O'odham Code**
14 **Chapter 1, Article 4, Section 1402(F); and**

15 **WHEREAS, the approved FY 2022 Department of Health and Human Services Division of Child**
16 **Welfare Tribal Child Welfare Budget provides funding for the Professional**
17 **Services Agreement; and**

18 **WHEREAS, the Health and Human Services Committee has reviewed the agreement and**
19 **recommends its approval.**

20 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**
21 **Professional Services Agreement between the Tohono O'odham Nation and**
22 **Intermountain Centers for Human Development, Inc. in substantially the form**
23 **attached.**

24 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham**
25 **Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to execute and**
26 **administer the FY 2022 Department of Health and Human Services Division of**
27 **Child Welfare Program Professional Services Agreement, provided that any**
28 **amendments shall be submitted for prior approval by the Tohono O'odham**
29 **Legislative Council.**

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




