2		conclude agreements and contracts on behalf of the Tohono O'odham Nation
3		with Federal, State and local governments and other Indian tribes or their
4		departments, agencies, or political subdivisions, or with private persons or
5		organizations on all matters within the authority of the Tohono O'odham
6		Council." (Constitution, Article VI, Section 1(f)); and
7	WHEREAS,	the Professional Services Agreement between the Tohono O'odham Nation
8		("Nation") and Intermountain Centers for Human Development, Inc.
9		("Intermountain") will allow Intermountain to provide residential and foster
10		care services for the Nation's Children In Need of Care for the period of October l,
11		2021 to September 30, 2022; and
12	WHEREAS,	the Professional Services Agreement is in excess of \$500,000.00, and therefore
13		requires Legislative Council approval, pursuant to 26 Tohono O'odham Code
14		Chapter 1, Article 4, Section 1402(F); and
15	WHEREAS,	the approved FY 2022 Department of Health and Human Services Division of Child
16		Welfare Tribal Child Welfare Budget provides funding for the Professional
17		Services Agreement; and
18	WHEREAS,	the Health and Human Services Committee has reviewed the agreement and
19		recommends its approval.
20	NOW, THERE	FORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the
21		Professional Services Agreement between the Tohono O'odham Nation and
22		Intermountain Centers for Human Development, Inc. in substantially the form
23		attached.
24	BE IT FINALI	LY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham
25		Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to execute and
26		administer the FY 2022 Department of Health and Human Services Division of
27		Child Welfare Program Professional Services Agreement, provided that any
28		amendments shall be submitted for prior approval by the Tohono O'odham
29		Legislative Council.
