

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Appointing Sherman Indian High School Board Member)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 21-433**

1 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is vested with the power to "promote,  
2 protect and provide for public health, peace, morals, education and general  
3 welfare of the Tohono O'odham Nation and its members" and to "provide for,  
4 appoint, or provide for the appointment of, and prescribe the duties and powers  
5 of committees, boards, officers and agents" (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham  
6 Nation, Article VI, Section 1(b) and (c)(2)); and

7 **WHEREAS,** a large number of Tohono O'odham Nation members attend Sherman Indian  
8 High School in Riverside, California, and the Nation is entitled to representation  
9 on the Sherman Indian High School Board ("Board"); and

10 **WHEREAS,** Sherman Indian High School is governed by its Board, which is comprised of nine  
11 members and their alternates to be determined in part as follows:

12 Federally recognized Indian tribes/communities or areas as applicable  
13 who have students attending Sherman, shall be entitled to appoint one (1)  
14 Member and one (1) Alternate. The five (5) tribal groups with the highest  
15 number of students enrolled effective at the end of the ISEP Residential  
16 Count Window in October will be able to appoint a single Member and  
17 Alternate from their respective tribes.

18 (Constitution and Bylaws of Sherman Indian High School Board, Article IV,  
19 Section 2.A.); and

20 **WHEREAS,** Board members and alternates shall be residents of the Indian Communities or  
21 areas from which they are elected or appointed, must be at least 21 years of age,  
22 cannot be employees of the Bureau of Indian Affairs or Bureau of Indian  
23 Education, although Board membership "is not restricted to parents of students"  
24 (Constitution and Bylaws, Article IV, Section 2.E., 2.F. and 2.I.); and

25 **WHEREAS,** Board members and alternates shall serve four-year terms contingent upon the  
26 student Residential Count (Constitution and Bylaws, Article IV, Section 3); and

27 **WHEREAS,** the Constitution and Bylaws provide that the election or appointment of a Board  
28 member shall become official upon "filing a resolution or letter of  
29 election/appointment with the School's Administrative Secretary" and after  
30 official action by the Board (Constitution and Bylaws, Article IV, Section 2.H.); and

31 **WHEREAS,** by Resolution No. 18-371, the Legislative Council nominated Jennifer Parker-  
32 Allen to the Sherman Indian High School Board and Camilla Toro as alternate;  
33 and

1 WHEREAS, effective August 2, 2021, Ms. Jennifer Parker-Allen resigned her position on the  
2 Sherman Indian High School Board and Ms. Camilla Toro expressed interest in  
3 serving as a Sherman Indian High School Board member; and

4 WHEREAS, the Legislative Human Resources Development Committee, having legislative  
5 oversight on matters relating to education including any "activity of a tribal,  
6 federal, state or local government" which relates to education services, has  
7 interviewed appointee Camilla Toro (Plan of Operation for Human Resources  
8 Development Committee, Article III.C.3.(a) and (b)); and

9 WHEREAS, the Legislative Human Resources Development Committee recommends  
10 appointing Camilla Toro, a member and resident of the Tohono O'odham Nation,  
11 and who otherwise meets the requirements for Board membership set forth in  
12 the Constitution and Bylaws of the Sherman Indian High School Board, to the  
13 Sherman Indian High School Board.

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council appoints  
15 Camilla Toro to the Sherman Indian High School Board.

16 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 17<sup>TH</sup>  
17 day of NOVEMBER, 2021 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,218.0 FOR;  
18 -0- AGAINST; [01]NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by,  
19 Article VI, Section 1(b) and (c)(2) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by  
20 the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant  
21 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June  
22 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).


