8		relinguish their membership with the Tohono O'odham Nation and the members
9		are identified in the December 2021 Relinquishment List, which is incorporated

11	WHEREAS,	pursuant to Article IX Section 1 of the Enrollment Ordinance,
12		A member of the Nation may relinquish his membership in the
13		Nation by submitting a written statement clearly expressing an
14		intent to relinguish his membership to the Council, a copy of
15		which must be served on the committee. The written statement
16		must be signed by the person wishing to relinquish his membership
17		or, if a minor or incompetent, by the parent(s), guardian or other
18		person legally authorized to act on his behalf. Relinquishment
19		does not require the approval of the Council, but is effective upon
20		receipt of the statement by the Council and cannot be subsequently
21		denied. Upon recognition by the Council that the individual has
22		renounced his membership, his name shall be deleted from the
23		membership roll.

25		recognizes that two individuals identified in the December 2021 Relinquishment
26		List have relinquished their membership in the Tohono O'odham Nation and
