11		is incorporated by this reference and which will adjust operational and/or
12		personnel line items; and
13	WHEREAS,	the FY 2022 Department of Education Higher Education Services Budget
14		Amendment No. 1 will increase the FY 2022 Higher Education Services Budget by
15		\$100,575.00 from \$923,787.85 to \$1,024,362.85; and
16	WHEREAS,	the Human Resources Development and Budget and Finance Committees have
17		reviewed the FY 2022 Department of Education Higher Education Services Budget
18		Amendment No. 1 and recommend its approval.
19	NOW, THERE	FORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the
20		FY 2022 Department of Education Higher Education Services Budget Amendment
21		No. 1 effective October 1, 2021, which includes a \$100,575.00 increase from
22		\$923,787.85 to \$1,024,362.85 that shall be funded by FY 2021 Department of
23		Education Higher Education Services Budget carry forward funds.
