12		Probation Building project; and
13	WHEREAS,	the Judicial Branch has prepared and submitted for review and approval its FY
14		2021 New Probation Building Budget Amendment No. 1, which is incorporated by
15		this reference and which will adjust operational and/or capital line items; and
16	WHEREAS,	the FY 2021 Judicial Branch New Probation Building Budget Amendment No. 1 will
17		not change the budget amount of \$2,042,909.86; and
18	WHEREAS,	the Judiciary and Budget and Finance Committees have reviewed the FY 2021
19		Judicial Branch New Probation Building Budget Amendment No. 1 and
20		recommend its approval.
