1	WHEREAS,	the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation ("Nation") vests the Legislative
2		Council with the authority to "promote, protect and provide for public health,
3		peace, morals, education and general welfare of the Tohono O'odham Nation and
4		its members" and "to purchase or otherwise acquire property." (Constitution,
5		Article VI, Section 1(c)(2) and 1(i)(3)); and
6	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds
7		within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation and to appropriate
8		these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll
9		expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"
10		authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham
11		Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and
12	WHEREAS,	the Nation compacts with the U.S. Indian Health Service ("IHS") through P.L. 93-
13		638, the Indian Self-Determination and Education Assistance Act, as amended, to
14	2	administer health care services to eligible members; and
15	WHEREAS,	there currently are no Nation health care clinics in or near the Nation's northern
16		reservation area and tribal members must travel an average of 70 miles to access
17		the Nation's existing heath care services located at the Santa Rosa Clinic, the San
18		Simon Health Center, the San Xavier Health Center, and the Sells Hospital; and
19	WHEREAS,	a community of approximately 717 tribal members reside both on and off-
20		reservation in the communities of Casa Grande, Arizona City, Eloy, Florence, and
21		Maricopa and must travel these lengthy distances to obtain Purchased Referred
22		Care ("PRC") services when an Indian Health Service or tribal facility is not
23		available, or does not provide the required care, necessitating a referral to a
24		private health care provider; and
25	WHEREAS,	by Resolution No. 19-178, the Legislative Council accepted an IHS Small
26		Ambulatory Program ("SAP") Grant in the amount of \$900,000, which was granted
27		to fund the purchase and renovation of a Nation's health care clinic in Casa
28		Grande, Arizona to provide ambulatory care and a full spectrum of family
29		medicine, urgent care, pharmacy and referral services; and
30	WHEREAS,	at the time of the award, the facility in the Nation's SAP grant application was sold,
31		delaying the action of entering into an actual grant contract with IHS to receive

RESOLUTION NO. 21-473 (Approving FY 2022 Tohono O'odham Nation Health Care Casa Grande Clinic Budget and Authorizing Purchase Offers for a Health Care Clinic and Vacant Lot) Page 2 of 5 the funds until a new written proposal could be submitted to IHS for approval; and WHEREAS, IHS notified the Nation that the SAP grant will be rescinded if the Nation does not submit a new project proposal by January 26, 2022, however, if an acceptable project proposal is received by the deadline, IHS will finalize the award contract and transfer the funds; and WHEREAS, in 2017, the Sonosky, Chambers, Sachse, Endreson & Perry, LLP law firm donated \$100,000 to the Nation, in the memory of Richard Ramirez who passed away February 14, 2017, to fund a new Casa Grande clinic; and an additional \$1,500,000 (beyond the \$900,000 from the SAP grant and the WHEREAS, \$100,000 from Sonosky) will be required from Nation's funds to purchase the health clinic and vacant lot; and WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Healthcare ("TONHC") Governing Body was delegated the authority to review and approve all TONHC budgets and budgets expending health self-governance funds, including budgets expending such funds for supporting programs within the Nation's departments, subject to Legislative Council oversight committee review and final approval by Legislative Council resolution (Tohono O'odham Nation Healthcare Governing Body Bylaws, Section 9403(A)); and WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Health Care has prepared and submitted for review and approval its FY 2022 Casa Grande Clinic Budget, which is incorporated by this reference, in the amount of \$2,500,000; and the Tohono O'odham Nation Health Care is seeking authorization to negotiate WHEREAS, and execute a purchase offer for the following property that can be used as the TONHC Casa Grande Health Care Clinic ("Clinic"): 1. Pinal County Assessor Parcel Number 505-82-0150, with a physical address at 1876 E Sabin Drive, Casa Grande, Arizona 85122, which is a contiguous +/- 6,065 square foot medical/office space within a +/-9,134 multi-tenant office project ; and

the Tohono O'odham Nation Health Care is also seeking authorization to

negotiate and execute a purchase offer for the following vacant lot that may
