

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY 2022 Department of Natural Resources Tribal Historic Preservation
Office National Park Service Carry Over Budget)**

RESOLUTION NO. 22-008

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds**
2 **within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to appropriate**
3 **these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll**
4 **expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"**
5 **authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham**
6 **Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and**

7 **WHEREAS, the FY 2019 Department of Natural Resources Cultural Affairs Tribal Historic**
8 **Preservation Office Budget in the amount of \$90,041.00 was approved by**
9 **Resolution No. 18-377; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the Department of Natural Resources has prepared and submitted for review and**
11 **approval its FY 2022 Tribal Historic Preservation Office National Park Service**
12 **Carry Over Budget, which is incorporated by this reference, in the amount of**
13 **\$9,921.99 to be funded by FY 2019 carry over funds; and**

14 **WHEREAS, the Cultural Preservation and Budget and Finance Committees have reviewed the**
15 **FY 2022 Department of Natural Resources Tribal Historic Preservation Office**
16 **National Park Service Carry Over Budget and recommend its approval.**

17 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**
18 **FY 2022 Department of Natural Resources Tribal Historic Preservation Office**
19 **National Park Service Carry Over Budget effective October 1, 2021 through March**
20 **31, 2022 in the amount of \$9,921.99, which shall be funded by FY 2019 carry over**
21 **funds.**

22 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham**
23 **Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to administer and**
24 **expend the FY 2022 Department of Natural Resource Tribal Historic Preservation**
25 **Office National Park Service Carry Over Budget, provided that any amendments**
26 **or modifications shall be submitted for prior approval by the Tohono O'odham**
27 **Legislative Council.**

28 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 10TH**
29 **day of JANUARY, 2022 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,218.0 FOR; -0-**
30 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and -0- ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by,**
31 **Article VI, Section 1(d)(2) and (3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by**
32 **the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
33 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
34 **18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**


