2		Nation, or which are stored in the Tohono O'odham Nation, whether found on the
3		surface or underground, are a valuable public resource of the Tohono O'odham
4		Nation to be protected to for the present and future use of the Tohono O'odham
5		Nation as a whole." (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, Article XVII,
6		Section 1); and
7	WHEREAS,	the Legislative Council is vested with "the control and management of these
8		waters" and the power to "[d]etermine how these waters shall be developed, used
9		and conserved for the greatest public benefit" and to "[e]nter into agreements,
10		compacts or other contracts for the beneficial use, sale or lease or distribution of
11		these waters" and "[t]o administer land and other public property, and by law,
12	1	ordinance or resolutionto manage protect, preserve and regulate the use of the
13		property, wildlife, land, air and natural resources (including surface and ground
14		waters) of the Tohono O'odham Nation." (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham
15		Nation, Article XVII, Section 2(a) and (b) and Article VI, Section 1(i)(2)); and
16	WHEREAS,	by Resolution No. 19-372, the Legislative Council approved the Tohono O'odham
17		Nation Long-Term Storage Credit Marketing Plan, which is a confidential
18		document; and
19	WHEREAS,	Tom Harbour drafted Addendum No. 1 to the Tohono O'odham Nation Long-Term
20		Storage Credit Marketing Plan, which is incorporated by this reference; and
21	WHEREAS,	Water Resources Committee has reviewed Addendum No. 1 to the Tohono
22		O'odham Nation Long-Term Storage Credit Marketing Plan and recommends its
23		approval.
24	NOW, THER	EFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves
25		Addendum No. 1 to the Tohono O'odham Nation Long-Term Storage Credit
26		Marketing Plan as presented in closed session, provided that any sales contract
27		shall be submitted for approval to the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.
