

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Approving Addendum No. 1 to the Tohono O'odham Nation Long-Term  
Storage Credit Marketing Plan)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 22-010**

1 **WHEREAS, "All waters which originate in or flow in, into or through the Tohono O'odham**  
2 **Nation, or which are stored in the Tohono O'odham Nation, whether found on the**  
3 **surface or underground, are a valuable public resource of the Tohono O'odham**  
4 **Nation to be protected to for the present and future use of the Tohono O'odham**  
5 **Nation as a whole." (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, Article XVII,**  
6 **Section 1); and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council is vested with "the control and management of these**  
8 **waters" and the power to "[d]etermine how these waters shall be developed, used**  
9 **and conserved for the greatest public benefit" and to "[e]nter into agreements,**  
10 **compacts or other contracts for the beneficial use, sale or lease or distribution of**  
11 **these waters" and "[t]o administer land and other public property, and by law,**  
12 **ordinance or resolution...to manage protect, preserve and regulate the use of the**  
13 **property, wildlife, land, air and natural resources (including surface and ground**  
14 **waters) of the Tohono O'odham Nation." (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham**  
15 **Nation, Article XVII, Section 2(a) and (b) and Article VI, Section 1(i)(2)); and**

16 **WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 19-372, the Legislative Council approved the Tohono O'odham**  
17 **Nation Long-Term Storage Credit Marketing Plan, which is a confidential**  
18 **document; and**

19 **WHEREAS, Tom Harbour drafted Addendum No. 1 to the Tohono O'odham Nation Long-Term**  
20 **Storage Credit Marketing Plan, which is incorporated by this reference; and**

21 **WHEREAS, Water Resources Committee has reviewed Addendum No. 1 to the Tohono**  
22 **O'odham Nation Long-Term Storage Credit Marketing Plan and recommends its**  
23 **approval.**

24 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves**  
25 **Addendum No. 1 to the Tohono O'odham Nation Long-Term Storage Credit**  
26 **Marketing Plan as presented in closed session, provided that any sales contract**  
27 **shall be submitted for approval to the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

28 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 11<sup>TH</sup>**  
29 **day of JANUARY, 2022 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,661.5 FOR;**  
30 **556.5 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and -0- ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council**  
31 **by, Article XVII, Section 1 and Section 2(a) and (b), Article VI, Section 1(i)(2) of the Constitution of**  
32 **the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and**  
33 **approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6,**  
34 **1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**
