## RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL (Authorizing the Creation of an Entity under the Laws of Mexico)

**RESOLUTION NO. 22-028** 

1	WHEREAS,	the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation vests the Legislative Council with
2		the authority "to promote, protect and provide for public health, peace, morals,
3		education and general welfare of the Tohono O'odham Nation and its members"
4		(Constitution, Article VI, Section 1(c)(2)) and "to authorize, charter and regulate
5		public or private corporations and associations whether organized for profit, or
6		for non-profit or charitable purposes" (Constitution, Article VI, Section 1(b); and
7	WHEREAS,	the Nation's executives seek approval to create a Mexican legal entity that will: (1)
8		be formed by two partnersthe Nation and a limited liability company created by
9		the Nation under the laws of the State of Delaware; (2) pursue the Nation's goal of
10		economic self-sufficiency, self-governance and self-determination; and (3) carry
11		out all actions necessary to acquire lands in Mexico, that are considered to be the
12		traditional homelands of the Tohono O'odham people, and promote tribal and
13		economic development within these lands; and
14	WHEREAS,	the Nation must grant and confer to the Nation's Mexican attorney, a Special
15		Power of Attorney, to act on behalf of and in the name of the Nation to form and to
16		do everything necessary to legally organize the Mexican entity; and
17	WHEREAS,	the Agricultural and Natural Resources Committee has reviewed this Resolution
18		and recommends its approval.
19	NOW, THERI	EFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council:
20		1. Approves the creation of a legal entity under the laws of Mexico as
21	1	described herein.
22		2. Agrees that the legal entity's purpose will be to pursue the Nation's goal of
23		economic self-sufficiency and carry out all actions necessary to acquire
24		lands in Mexico, that are considered to be the traditional homelands of the
25		Tohono O'odham people, and to promote tribal and economic
26		development within these lands.
27		3. Authorizes the Chairman, Ned Norris, Jr., or his official designee to sign all
28		documents and undertake all actions necessary to carry out the purposes
29	1	of this resolution, including granting and conferring on the Nation's

Mexican attorney, a Special Power of Attorney, to act on behalf of and in

the name of the Nation for the purposes set forth herein.
