

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Amending Resolution No. 21-439 "Approving the 2022 Tohono O'odham  
Nation Regional Needs and Assets Report")**

**RESOLUTION NO. 22-065**

1 **WHEREAS, the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation vests the Tohono O'odham**  
2 **Legislative with the authority to "promote, protect and provide for public health,**  
3 **peace, morals, education and general welfare of the Tohono O'odham Nation and**  
4 **its members . . ." and to "consult, negotiate and conclude agreements and**  
5 **contracts on behalf of the Tohono O'odham Nation with Federal, State and local**  
6 **governments and other Indian tribes or their departments, agencies, or political**  
7 **subdivisions, or with private persons or organizations on all matters within the**  
8 **authority of the Tohono O'odham Council" (Constitution, Article VI, Section 1(c)(2)**  
9 **and Section 1(f)); and**

10 **WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 21-439, the Legislative Council approved the 2022 Tohono**  
11 **O'odham Nation Regional Needs and Assets Report for First Things First ("FTF");**  
12 **and**

13 **WHEREAS, while Resolution No. 21-439 mentioned a supplemental study in collaboration**  
14 **with the University of Arizona, Resolution No. 21-439 did not authorize a**  
15 **supplemental study with Arizona State University to identify FTF regions and sub-**  
16 **regions at a heightened risk for child maltreatment and/or poor family outcomes**  
17 **and to estimate the potential beneficiaries of home visiting services at varying**  
18 **risk levels in FTF regions to inform regional strategic planning and to utilize data**  
19 **included in the data indicator list; and**

20 **WHEREAS, FTF presented the requested amendment to the Human Resources Development**  
21 **Committee, which recommends approval.**

22 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council amends**  
23 **Resolution No. 21-439 as follows with the underlined language added to the**  
24 **original resolved clause:**

25 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**  
26 **First Things First Tohono O'odham Regional Partnership Council to perform the**  
27 **following actions:**

- 28 **1. Collect unidentified (no personal information such as names, address,**  
29 **telephone numbers, social security numbers, etc.) tribal and community**  
30 **data from the data sources in the attached list of data sources relevant to**  
31 **young children birth through five years old and their families residing on**  
32 **the Tohono O'odham Nation.**



2. To contract services from the University of Arizona and Arizona State University to compile collected data and draft the 2022 Tohono O'odham Nation Regional Needs and Assets Report, Additional Work, and Base Expansion Report.
3. Request and receive unidentified Women, Infants and Children (WIC) data from the Inter Tribal Council of Arizona that can be directly submitted to FTE.
4. Submit the compiled 2022 Tohono O'odham Nation Regional Needs and Assets Report, inclusive of the supplemental reports, to the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council for a thirty calendar day review and comment prior to publication or dissemination of the final report.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 17<sup>TH</sup> day of FEBRUARY, 2022 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,218.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and -0- ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by, Article VI, Section 1(c)(2) and Section 1(f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
