

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving an Intergovernmental Agreement between Pinal County and the
Tohono O'odham Nation for Animal Care and Control Services)

RESOLUTION NO. 22-071

1 **WHEREAS, the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation vests the Legislative**
2 **Council with the power to "consult, negotiate and conclude agreements and**
3 **contracts on behalf of the Tohono O'odham Nation with Federal, State and local**
4 **governments and other Indian tribes or their departments, agencies, or political**
5 **subdivisions, or with private persons or organizations on all matters within the**
6 **authority of the Tohono O'odham Council." (Constitution, Article VI, Section 1(f));**
7 **and**

8 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation ("Nation"), from time to time, needs animal care and**
9 **control services from neighboring jurisdictions, such as Pinal County; and**

10 **WHEREAS, Pinal County is willing to provide the Nation animal care and control assistance**
11 **on an as-requested, as-available basis through its Pinal County Animal Care and**
12 **Control Department; and**

13 **WHEREAS, the Nation and Pinal County have negotiated an Intergovernmental Agreement**
14 **("IGA"), which is incorporated by this reference, and which provides the terms**
15 **and conditions for the Nation to receive animal care and control services from**
16 **Pinal County; and**

17 **WHEREAS, the initial term of the IGA shall be for a period of three years, with an automatic**
18 **renewal for two additional one-year terms (second and third terms); and**

19 **WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs Committee has reviewed the IGA and recommends its**
20 **approval.**

21 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**
22 **Intergovernmental Agreement between the Tohono O'odham Nation and Pinal**
23 **County and authorizes the Nation's chairperson or any designated official to**
24 **execute it in substantially the form attached.**

25 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 17TH**
26 **day of FEBRUARY, 2022 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,218.0 FOR;**
27 **-0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [01] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by,**
28 **Article VI, Section 1(f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
29 **O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
30 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934**
31 **(48 Stat.984).**

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


