

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**

**RESOLUTION NO. 22-072**

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds**  
2 **within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to appropriate**  
3 **these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll**  
4 **expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"**  
5 **authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham**  
6 **Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Department of Public Safety applied for and was awarded the Arizona**  
8 **Attorney General's Office Law Enforcement Safety Equipment Funding in the**  
9 **amount of \$27,000 for the period of October 1, 2020 through September 30, 2021**  
10 **which was approved by Resolution No. 20-378; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the Department of Public Safety requested and received a no cost extension to**  
12 **expend the remaining funds through June 30, 2022; and**

13 **WHEREAS, the Department of Public Safety has prepared and submitted for review and**  
14 **approval its FY 2022 Arizona Attorney General's Office Law Enforcement Safety**  
15 **Equipment Funding Program Budget, which is incorporated by this reference, in**  
16 **the amount of \$5,535.79, to be funded by the Nation's general fund pending**  
17 **reimbursement by the grantor, Arizona Attorney General's Office; and**

18 **WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs and Budget and Finance Committees have reviewed the FY**  
19 **2022 Arizona Attorney General's Office Law Enforcement Safety Equipment**  
20 **Funding Program Budget and recommend its approval.**

21 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council:**

22 (1) **accepts the Arizona Attorney General's Office Law Enforcement Safety**  
23 **Equipment Funding no cost extension; and**

24 (2) **approves the FY 2022 Arizona Attorney General's Office Law Enforcement**  
25 **Safety Equipment Funding Program Budget, effective October 1, 2021**  
26 **through June 30, 2022, in the amount of \$5,535.79, which shall be funded**  
27 **by the Nation's general fund pending reimbursement by the grantor,**  
28 **Arizona Attorney General's Office.**

29 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham**  
30 **Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to administer and**  
31 **expend the FY 2022 Arizona Attorney General's Office Law Enforcement Safety**  
32 **Equipment Funding Program Budget, provided that any amendments or**



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
modifications shall be submitted for prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.
