

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving 2022 Amendments to Compact)**

RESOLUTION NO. 22-083

1 **WHEREAS,** the Legislative Council is vested with the power to “consult, negotiate and
2 conclude agreements and contracts on behalf of the Tohono O’odham Nation
3 with Federal, State and local governments and other Indian tribes or their
4 departments, agencies, or political subdivisions, or with private persons or
5 organizations on all matters within the authority of the Tohono O’odham
6 Council” (Constitution of the Tohono O’odham Nation, Article VI, Section 1(f)); and
7 **WHEREAS,** the Indian Gaming Regulatory Act, 25 U.S.C. § 2701 et seq., confirms that an Indian
8 tribe is authorized to conduct Class III Gaming on its Indian Lands pursuant to a
9 tribal-state gaming compact; and
10 **WHEREAS,** by Resolution No. 21-087, the Tohono O’odham Nation approved, and authorized
11 the Nation’s chairman to enter into, amendments to Gaming Compact between
12 the Tohono O’odham Nation-State of Arizona (the Compact”), and the chairman
13 did enter into the Compact, which became effective on May 24, 2021 with
14 publication of approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs; and
15 **WHEREAS,** Arizona tribes and the State have reached agreement on additional amendments
16 to the Compact (“2022 Amendments to Compact”), including the Agreement to
17 Amend Compact Between the Tohono O’odham Nation and State of Arizona,
18 which are incorporated by this reference; and
19 **WHEREAS,** the Gaming Negotiating Committee recommends that the Legislative Council
20 grant final approval of the 2022 Amendments to Compact and authorize the
21 Nation’s chairperson to execute the Amendments.

22 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O’odham Legislative Council approves the
23 2022 amendments to the Compact substantially in the form presented to the
24 Legislative Council on February 23, 2022 and authorizes the Nation’s chairperson
25 to execute the Amendments and take any additional actions consistent with this
26 Resolution that are necessary to achieve full execution of the 2022 Amendments
27 to the Compact.

28 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O’odham Legislative Council on the 23RD**
29 **day of FEBRUARY, 2022 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,218.0 FOR;**
30 **-0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and -0- ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by,**
31 **Article VI, Section 1(f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O’odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
32 **O’odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
33 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934**
