

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving Nineteen Tribal Nations Service Provider Agreement)**




- 1 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized to "consult, negotiate and
2 conclude agreements and contracts on behalf of the Tohono O'odham Nation
3 with Federal, State and local governments and other Indian tribes or their
4 departments, agencies, or political subdivisions, or with private persons or
5 organizations on all matters within the authority of the Tohono O'odham
6 Council." (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation Article VI, Section 1(f)); and
7 **WHEREAS,** workforce development and training is crucial to the Nation's members who need
8 assistance in obtaining employment and training on the Tohono O'odham
9 Nation; and
10 **WHEREAS,** the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act ("WIOA"), Public Law 113-128
11 provides that there shall be established in each local area of a State, and certified
12 by the Governor of the State, a local workforce development board; and
13 **WHEREAS,** the Nineteen Tribal Nations ("NTN") Workforce Development Local Area is
14 comprised of thirteen tribal nations, including the Tohono O'odham Nation; and
15 **WHEREAS,** since 1983, the Nineteen Tribal Nations Local Workforce Development Board
16 ("LWDB") has provided assistance to tribal nations for the purpose of providing
17 workforce development and training opportunities in accordance with the WIOA;
18 and
19 **WHEREAS,** the U.S. Department of Labor distributes WIOA funding ("Funds") directly to the
20 Arizona Department of Economic Security ("ADES"), which then allocates the
21 Funds to the LWDB, which in turn allocates Funds to each of the member tribal
22 nations of the LWDB, including the Tohono O'odham Nation; and
23 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Nation Department of Education One Stop Division uses the
24 Funds to deliver services to tribal youth, adults, and dislocated workers who seek
25 employment and training; and
26 **WHEREAS,** the WIOA federal governing legislation requires local boards, such as LWDB, to
27 enter into a Service Provider Agreement with each Local Workforce Development
28 Area, which is incorporated by this reference, to specify the services to youth,
29 adults and dislocated workers seeking training and employment provided by the
30 Department of Education One Stop Division WIOA Tribal Office at a performance
31 level as agreed to by NTNWDB and ADES; and

1 **WHEREAS, the Service Provider Agreement takes effect upon signature of all parties and**
2 **continues until June 30, 2022; and**
3 **WHEREAS, the Human Resources Development Committee has reviewed the Service**
4 **Provider Agreement and recommends approval.**
5 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**
6 **Service Provider Agreement, substantially in the form attached, and authorizes**
7 **the Chairman of the Nation to execute it, provided that any amendments to the**
8 **Agreement shall be submitted for prior approval by the Tohono O'odham**
9 **Legislative Council.**

10 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 07TH**
11 **day of MARCH, 2022 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,218.0 FOR; -0-**
12 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [06] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by,**
13 **Article VI, Section 1(f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
14 **O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
15 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934**
16 **(48 Stat.984).**
