education and general welfare of the Tohono O'odham Nation and its members' (Constitution, Article VI, Section 1(c)(2)); and  WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation ("Nation") obtained a license from the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC") to operate KOHN FM, a non-commercial educational radio station, and after a year of broadcasting became eligible for funding from the Corporation for Public Broadcasting ("CPB"), an independent federal agency; and  WHEREAS, the Nation operates the KOHN FM radio station as a program under the Executive Branch as Hewel Ñi'oki ("Management"); and  WHEREAS, Community Service Grant from CPB for fiscal years 2020 and 2021; and such funding requires that the Nation conduct a stand-alone 2021 audit for Hewel Ñi'oki, operators and managers of KOHN FM radio, for which the Nation engaged CliftonLarsonAllen, LLP ("Auditors"); and  WHEREAS, CPB has adopted new eligibility requirements which state that a grant recipient of Community Service Grant funding must make its annual financial report publically available on-line on its website; and  WHEREAS, the Auditor's have completed the FY 2021 Hewel Ñi'oki audit in accordance with the CPB's Principles of Accounting and have submitted the accompanying Financial Statements for the Fiscal Year Ended September 30, 2021 (collectively the "Auditor's Report"); and  WHEREAS, the Chairperson and Vice Chairperson of the Nation, the Cultural Preservation Committee, and the Budget and Finance Committee have reviewed the Nation's FY 2021 Hewel Ñ'oki Auditor's Report.  NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council accepts and approves the FY 2021 Hewel Ñ'oki Auditor's Report.
