7	WHEREAS,	the Arizona State Legislature introduced Senate Bill 1300 to amend A.R.S. §15-
8		244.01 the Tribal College Dual Enrollment Program Fund; and
9	WHEREAS,	Senate Bill 1300 - tribal college dual enrollment program authorizes a tribal
10		college dual enrollment program to offer courses relating to tribal language,
11		government, culture or any college subject to student members of a tribe living
12		off of the reservation and to other students through intergovernmental
13		agreements with high schools that are located outside of a reservation; adds
14		books and instructional materials to the costs compensated by the Tribal College
15		Dual Enrollment Program Fund; and authorizes the Arizona Department of
16		Education Office of Indian Education to provide technical assistance to tribal
17		colleges and high schools in connection with initiating and operating a dual
18		enrollment program; and
19	WHEREAS,	the Human Resources Development and Appropriations Committees
20		recommend supporting Senate Bill 1300 or similar state legislation.
21	NOW, THERI	EFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council supports
22		Arizona Senate Bill 1300 - tribal college dual enrollment program or similar state
