1	WHEREAS,	the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation vests the Nation's chairperson
2		with authority to appoint the Nation's treasurer, and other officers and heads of
3		all governmental departments with the approval of the Tohono O'odham
4		Legislative Council (Constitution, Article VII, Section 2(e)); and
5	WHEREAS,	the Nation's Chairman Ned Norris, Jr. has appointed Dwayne Lopez as the Nation's
6		Department of Natural Resources executive director, subject to the approval of
7		the Legislative Council; and
8	WHEREAS,	the Appointed Officers law, 1 T.O.C. Chapter 4, establishes the process for review
9		of appointments by the appropriate oversight committee and the Council and the
10		documents required, including copies of the current job description, the
11		appointee's current resume, contact information, and current written
12		background investigation report; and
13	WHEREAS,	pursuant to Article III, Section 6(B) of the Legislative Rules of the Tohono
14		O'odham Legislative Council, the chairperson's "appointee to the position of
15		treasurer or other officers or heads of governmental departments shall not be
16		added to any Legislative Council session agenda for approval unless the
17		appropriate legislative committee interviews the appointee after receiving a
18		resume and written background investigation report" containing detailed
19		employment, education, credit, litigation, and other information necessary to
20		determine the appointee's qualifications and fitness; and
21	WHEREAS,	by Resolution No. 21-427, the Legislative Council repealed Resolution No. 20-121
22		"Suspending Timeframes in the Appointed Officers Law Due to the COVID-19
23		Pandemic" and authorized:
24		1. an appointee who has undergone the Appointed Officers process pursuant
25		to Section 4003(B) and (C) to proceed to the Legislative Council, provided
26		that the background investigation report shall be updated and reviewed
27		by the respective oversight committee prior to the appointee's interview
28		with the Legislative Council;
29		2. the start of the process of review and consideration pursuant to the
30		Appointed Officers law by the appropriate oversight committee regardless
31		of the status of the Legislative Branch offices closure, provided that a

1		background investigation report shall be considered valid for 90 days
2		after it is completed;
3		3. elimination of the in-person interview requirement in the Appointed
4 5		Officers law to allow virtual committee and Legislative Council interviews and
6	WHEREAS,	by Resolution No. 21-427, the Legislative Council further required that
7	ŕ	notwithstanding 1 Tohono O'odham Code Chapter 4, all appointees who have
8		served more than 180 days prior to the enactment of the aforementioned
9		resolution undergo the committee and Council review process pursuant to the
10		Appointed Officers Law for Council approval of the appointment within 120 days
11		of the effective date of the resolution; and
12	WHEREAS,	Natural Resources Department Executive Director Appointee, Dwayne Lopez, was
13		appointed by Chairman Ned Norris Jr. on March 9, 2020, more than 180 days prior
14		to the enactment of Council Resolution No. 21-427 and required Council approval
15		by March 22, 2022 in order to continue to perform the functions of, or be
16		compensated for performing the duties of, an appointed officer pursuant to the
17		Appointed Officers law; and
18	WHEREAS,	due to an emergency, Dwayne Lopez is currently unavailable to undergo the
19		interview process by the Legislative Council Agricultural and Natural Resources
20		Committee and subsequent full Council interview before March 22, 2022; and
21	WHEREAS,	the Legislative Council Agricultural and Natural Resources Committee has
22		received notice of the extenuating circumstances of the emergency and
23		recommend a 30 day extension beyond the 120 day timeframe established by
24		Council Resolution No. 21-427.
25	NOW, THER	EFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves a 30
26		day extension for Natural Resources Executive Director Appointee Dwayne Lopez
27		to undergo the committee and Council review process pursuant to the Appointed
28		Officers law, which shall not exceed April 21, 2022, unless approved by
29		subsequent Council resolution.
