6		all federal appropriation estimates and projects for the benefit of the Tohono
7		O'odham Nation and all federal appropriation estimates and projects for the
8		benefit of the Tohono O'odham Nation" (Constitution, Article VI, Section 1(c)(2)
9		and Section 1(j)); and
10	WHEREAS,	on March 21, 2022, Senator Mark Kelly and Senator Kyrsten Sinema announced
11		the deadline for submission of FY 2023 congressionally directed funding
12		requests, previously called earmarks; and
13	WHEREAS,	congressionally directed funding projects limit the total amount that can be
14		requested, require that the funding projects be posted online and have
15		community support, and only allow requests from states, local or tribal
16		governments and non-profits; and
17	WHEREAS,	Senator Mark Kelly and Senator Kyrsten Sinema's deadline for submission of
18		project requests is April 6, 2022; and
19	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Nation Planning and Economic Development Department
20		conducted a Road Safety Assessment for BIA Route 19 and Nation's members
21		provided feedback that without turning lanes for Baboquivari High School, which
22		is located on BIA Route 19, parents and students are concerned with vehicles
23		traveling at a high rate of speed during peak traffic hours; and
24	WHEREAS,	turning lanes would improve the flow of traffic, reduce safety risks, and generally
25		benefit Nation's members, members of the public, and law enforcement using
26		BIA Route 19, including United States Border Patrol; and
27	WHEREAS,	the Nation's BIA Route 19 turning lanes at Baboquivari High School
28		congressionally directed funding proposal requests \$1,016,458.07 to complete
29		construction; and
