## RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

(Extending the Timeframe for the Appointment of Nation's Department of Human Resources Executive Director Appointee Doreen Thomas)

## DEFEATED RESOLUTION NO. 22-186

1	WHEREAS,	the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation vests the Nation's chairperson
2		with authority to appoint the Nation's treasurer, and other officers and heads of
3		all governmental departments with the approval of the Tohono O'odham
4		Legislative Council (Constitution, Article VII, Section 2(e)); and
5	WHEREAS,	the Nation's Chairman Ned Norris, Jr. appointed Doreen Thomas as the Nation's
6		Department of Human Resources executive director on September 14, 2021,
7		subject to the approval of the Legislative Council; and
8	WHEREAS,	the Appointed Officers law, 1 T.O.C. Chapter 4, establishes the process for
9		legislative review of appointments by the appropriate oversight committee and
10		the Council, and Section 4003(R) identifies the documents and information
11		required for review, including the current job description, appointee's current
12		resume, contact information, and current written background investigation
13		report; and
14	WHEREAS,	by Resolution No. 21-427, the Legislative Council repealed Resolution No. 20-121
15	1 1 1 1 1	"Suspending Timeframes in the Appointed Officers Law Due to the COVID-19
16		Pandemic" and, effective November 22, 2021, authorized "2. the start of the
17		process of review and consideration pursuant to the Appointed Officers law by the
18		appropriate oversight committee regardless of the status of the Legislative
19		Branch offices closure"; and
20	WHEREAS,	the Section 4003(B) documents, including a complete background investigation
21		report, required for committee review of Department of Human of Resources
22		Executive Director Appointee Doreen Thomas were due by March 22, 2022 in
23		order for the Appointee to continue to perform the functions of, or be
24		compensated for performing the duties of, an appointed officer pursuant to the
25		Appointed Officers law (1 T.O.C. Chapter 4, Section 4003(F)); and
26	WHEREAS,	on March 24, 2022, the Human Resources Development Committee notified
27		Chairman Norris that the background investigation report provided for
28		Executive Director Appointee Doreen Thomas was incomplete; and
29	WHEREAS,	due to unforeseen delays in background investigations caused by incomplete or
30		insufficient information provided, the complete Section 4003(B) documents for
31		Appointee Doreen Thomas were not provided to the Legislative Council Human
32		Resources Development Committee within the required timeframe; and

Chapter 4; and 4 WHEREAS. the Human Resources Development Committee recommends approving the 5 extension of timeframes. 6 NOW. THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council extends the 7 deadline for submitting complete Section 4003(B) documents for Human 8 Resources Department Executive Director Appointee Doreen Thomas to the Q Human Resources Development Committee; provided that the appointee shall not perform the functions of, or be compensated for performing the duties of, an 10 appointed officer after June 15, 2022 unless she is appointed by Legislative 11 12 Council resolution or the Legislative Council approves an additional extension by 13 resolution.
