18	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Nation is authorized to acquire replacement lands under
19		the terms of the Gila Bend Indian Reservation Lands Replacement Act, which
20		lands the Secretary of the Interior "shall hold in trust for the benefit" of the Nation
21		(Pub. L. 99-503, Section 6(d)); and
22	WHEREAS,	under the terms of the Gila Bend Indian Reservation Lands Replacement Act,
23		such trust lands shall be deemed an Indian reservation "for all purposes" (Pub. L.

26		unincorporated Maricopa County near the intersection of the Northern Parkway

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, pending the Secretary of the Interior's acquisition of the Far West Valley Area in trust on behalf of the Tohono O'odham Nation in accordance with the Gila Bend Indian Reservation Lands Replacement Act, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council authorizes and directs the Tohono O'odham Gaming Enterprise, subject to existing Legislative Council resolutions and agreements, including but not limited to any outstanding leases and any agreements between the Nation and San Lucy District, to:

- (1) utilize, improve, maintain, operate and manage the Far West Valley Area to carry out the purposes of the Charter; and
- (2) enter into any necessary service line agreements for the provision of utility services to the Far West Valley Area in order to carry out the purposes of the Charter:
- (3) authorize draws upon escrowed funds to complete certain improvements identified in the Amended and Restated Joint Development Agreement approved by Resolution No. 21-255 (the "JDA"); and
- (4) pay, when and as the same become due and payable, all fees and costs for the Enterprise's utilization, improvement, maintenance, operation and management, including but not limited to all infrastructure development costs, including contributions required pursuant to the terms of the JDA, and all taxes, assessments, licenses, fees, and other like charges levied upon or against the Far West Valley Area for which either the Enterprise or the Nation may become liable.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that nothing in this resolution constitutes an encumbrance of the Far West Valley Area.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 18TH day of MAY, 2022 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,218.0 FOR; -0-AGAINST; [01] NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by, Article VI, Section 1(e) and 1(i) and Article XVI, Section 1of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
