1	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Nation (the "Nation") is a federally recognized Indian tribe
2		organized pursuant to Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18,
3		1934 (48 Stat. 987; 25 U.S.C. § 476), which exercises sovereignty over both its
4		members and its lands; and
5	WHEREAS,	the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation vests the Tohono O'odham
6		Legislative Council with the power to acquire and administer land (Constitution,
7		Article VI, Section 1(i)); and
8	WHEREAS,	Article XVI, Section 1 of the Nation's Constitution provides
9		The unallotted lands of the Tohono O'odham Nation and all lands hereafter
10		acquired by the nation, or held for the use of the nation or its members, are a
11	-	valuable public resource and shall be held as national lands forever. Control
12		and management thereof are vested in the Tohono O'odham Council, which
13		may enact laws governing the use, assignment, permit, lease or other
14	1	disposition of lands, interests in land and resources of the nation consistent
15		with Federal law.

17	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Gaming Enterprise (the "Gaming Enterprise") is a wholly
18		$owned\ tribal\ government\ enterprise\ of\ the\ Nation\ established\ pursuant\ to\ Article$
19		VI, Section 1(e) of the Nation's Constitution and operated pursuant to the Charter
20	Λ.	of the Gaming Enterprise ("Charter"), 16 Tohono O'odham Code Chapter 2; and
21	WHEREAS,	Section 5(d)(6) of the Charter vests the Gaming Enterprise Management Board
22		with authority to "Utilize, improve, maintain, operate and manage, in the
23		ordinary course of business, all interests in real property held by the Enterprise,
24		including negotiation of leases or subleases of real property subject to approval
25		of the Legislative Council; provided however, that nothing in this Charter shall be
26		construed as authorizing the Enterprise to mortgage or encumber trust or
27		restricted real property of the Nation without the prior consent of the Legislative
28		Council"; and
29	WHEREAS,	in 2018, the Nation purchased approximately 11.168 acres of land located at 9219
30		West Northern Avenue, Glendale, Arizona ("Glendale Property"), which lands are
31		not held in trust by the United States; and

1	WHEREAS, the Nation and the Gaming Enterprise propose to enter into a Lease Agreement		
2	for Glendale Property ("Lease Agreement"), which is incorporated by this		
3	reference; and		
4	WHEREAS, the Commerce and Agricultural and Natural Resources Committees have		
5	reviewed the Lease Agreement and recommend that it be approved.		
6	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council		
7	(1) approves the Lease Agreement for Glendale Property in substantially the form		
8	incorporated herein; provided that the Enterprise shall not conduct gaming		
9	activities, as that term is defined in 16 T.O.C. Chapter 1, Section 201(j), on the		
10	Property, and		
11	(2) authorizes and directs the Nation's chairperson to execute the Agreement.
