

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY 2022 Baboquivari District Budget Amendments Funded by
Gaming Funds and Mining Royalties)**

RESOLUTION NO. 22-233

1 **WHEREAS,** pursuant to Article IX, Section 7 of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham
2 Nation,

3 No district council shall expend district funds except pursuant to budgets
4 authorized under resolutions of the district council and approved by the
5 Tohono O'odham Council. The management of these funds shall be only by
6 a treasurer or other authorized officer of the district council who has
7 furnished a surety bond satisfactory to the treasurer of the Tohono
8 O'odham Nation, and all expenditures of these funds shall be by checks
9 signed by such treasurer or other authorized officer and the chairman or
10 vice chairman of the district council.

12 **WHEREAS,** the FY 2022 Baboquivari District Budgets in the amount of \$5,193,817.36 were
13 authorized by Baboquivari District Council Resolution No. 2021-B-104 and
14 approved by Tohono O'odham Legislative Council Resolution No. 21-366, and
15 subsequently amended by Resolution Nos. 21-462, 22-049, and 22-139; and

16 **WHEREAS,** by Baboquivari District Council Resolution Nos. 2022-B-51, 2022-B-52, 2022-B-56,
17 and 2022-B-57, the Baboquivari District has authorized and submitted for review
18 and approval its FY 2022 Artesia/Little Tucson Community Budget Amendment
19 No. 1, FY 2022 Artesia/Little Tucson Community Building Project Budget
20 Amendment No. 1, FY 2022 Baboquivari District Administration Budget
21 Amendment No. 3, and FY 2022 South Komelic Community Budget Amendment
22 No. 2 (collectively, the "FY 2022 Baboquivari District Budget Amendments"),
23 which are incorporated by these references and which will adjust operational
24 and/or personnel line items; and

25 **WHEREAS,** the Budget and Finance Committee has reviewed the FY 2022 Baboquivari District
26 Budget Amendments and recommends its approval.

27 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the
28 FY 2022 Baboquivari District Budget Amendments effective October 1, 2021 as
29 follows:

- 30 (1) FY 2022 Baboquivari District Artesia/Little Tucson Community Budget
31 Amendment No. 1, which includes a \$156,321.95 decrease from
32 \$499,115.43 to \$342,793.48;

- 1 (2) FY 2022 Baboquivari District Administration Budget Amendment No. 3,
2 which will not change the FY 2022 Baboquivari District Administration
3 Budget of \$1,283,439.70;
- 4 (3) FY 2022 Baboquivari District South Komelic Community Budget
5 Amendment No. 2, which will not change the FY 2022 South Komelic
6 Community Budget of \$515,761.82; and
- 7 (4) FY 2022 Baboquivari District Artesia/Little Tucson Community Building
8 Project Budget Amendment No. 1, which includes a \$267,549.78 increase
9 from \$905,685.08 to \$1,173,234.86 that shall be funded as follows:
- 10 (a) FY 2018 Artesia/Little Tucson Community Carryover Funds in the
11 amount of \$94,581.44
- 12 (b) FY 2020 Artesia/Little Tucson Community Mining Royalties in the
13 amount of \$16,646.39
- 14 (c) FY 2022 Artesia/Little Tucson Community Budget Amendment No. 1 in
15 the amount of \$156,321.95.

16 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the FY 2022 Baboquivari District Budget Amendments will
17 increase the FY 2022 Baboquivari District Budgets by \$111,227.83 from
18 \$5,210,463.75 to \$5,321,691.58.

19 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the FY 2022
20 Baboquivari District Budgets as amended shall be managed and expended in
21 accordance with Article IX, Section 7 of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham
22 Nation and the Nation's laws, provided that any amendments or modifications
23 shall be authorized under District Council resolution and submitted for prior
24 approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.

25 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 14TH
26 day of JULY, 2022 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,829.10 FOR;-0-
27 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 388.9[05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council
28 by, Article IX, Section 7 the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono
29 O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
30 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934
31 (48 Stat.984).
