5		authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham
6		Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and
7	WHEREAS,	on June 17, 2021, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approved the FY 2021-
8		2024 Tribal Transportation Improvement Plan (TTIP), which included Tribal
9		Transportation Safety Plan for Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA)-owned roads
10		located throughout the Nation, by Resolution No. 21-214, and
11	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Nation ("Nation") was notified of Grant (Contract) No.
12		A22AV00486, PIR Tribal Transportation Safety Plan in the amount of \$12,500.00
13		from the U.S. BIA, effective March 02, 2022 through September 30, 2025; and
14	WHEREAS,	the purpose of the grant is to provide financial assistance to the Nation for the
15		provision of all labor, materials, equipment and services necessary to develop a
16		Tribal Strategic Transportation Safety Plan for safety planning and mitigation
17		measures; and
18	WHEREAS,	the grant objective is to prepare a Tribal Transportation Safety Plan to identify
19	•	transportation safety improvements based on input from staff, the community,
20		the Legislative Council and individuals within the Nation in cooperation with
21		local, federal and state governments. The Plan must meet U.S. DOT-Federal
22		Highway Administration standards; and
23	WHEREAS,	the Planning and Economic Development Department, Roads Program, has
24		prepared and submitted for review and approval its FY 2022 Tribal
25		Transportation Safety Plan Budget, which is incorporated by this reference, in
26		the amount of \$12,500.00; and
27	WHEREAS,	the Agricultural and Natural Resources and Budget and Finance Committees
28		have reviewed the Bureau of Indian Affairs Grant Award and the FY 2022 Tribal
29		Transportation Safety Plan Budget and recommend their approval.
30	NOW, THERE	FORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council accepts and
31		approves the Bureau of Indian Affairs Grant Award in the amount of \$12,500.00,
32		effective March 02, 2022 through September 30, 2025, for the purposes set forth
