

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Acceptance of the Bureau of Indian Affairs Grant Award and Approving FY 2022**  
**Transportation Planning Budget)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 22-241**

1 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds  
2 within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to appropriate  
3 these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll  
4 expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"  
5 authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham  
6 Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and

7 **WHEREAS,** on June 17, 2021, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approved the FY 2021-  
8 2024 Tribal Transportation Improvement Plan (TTIP), which included  
9 Transportation Planning by Resolution No. 21-214, and

10 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Nation (Nation) was notified of Grant (Contract) No.  
11 A22AV00491, PIR Transportation Planning in the amount of \$699,022.48 from the  
12 U.S. Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA), effective April 11, 2022 through September 30,  
13 2025; and

14 **WHEREAS,** the purpose of the grant is to provide financial assistance to the Nation for the  
15 provision of all labor, materials, equipment and services necessary to perform  
16 Transportation Coordination and Transportation Planning activities, including  
17 an update to the Long Range Transportation Plan (LTRP) and National Tribal  
18 Transportation Facility Inventory (NTTFI); and

19 **WHEREAS,** the grant objective is to provide funding for a tribal staff member to serve as the  
20 Nation's Transportation Coordinator and perform various transportation  
21 planning activities to enhance the Nation's ability to improve the transportation  
22 systems serving the Nation and improve intergovernmental relationships to  
23 effectively coordinate and facilitate highway safety, public transit, construction  
24 and maintenance projects; and

25 **WHEREAS,** the Planning and Economic Development Department, Roads Program, has  
26 prepared and submitted for review and approval its FY 2022 Planning  
27 Transportation Budget, which is incorporated by this reference, in the amount of  
28 \$699,022.48; and

29 **WHEREAS,** the Agricultural and Natural Resources and Budget and Finance Committees  
30 have reviewed the Bureau of Indian Affairs Grant Award and the FY 2022 Planning  
31 Transportation Budget and recommend their approval.

1 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council accepts and  
2 approves the Bureau of Indian Affairs Grant Award in the amount of \$699,022.48,  
3 effective April 11, 2022 through September 30, 2025, for the purposes set forth  
4 herein and, that shall be funded by the Nation's general fund pending  
5 reimbursement from the grantor, the Bureau of Indian Affairs.

6 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham  
7 Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to administer and  
8 expend FY 2022 Planning Transportation Budget, provided that any amendments  
9 or modifications shall be submitted for prior approval by the Tohono O'odham  
10 Legislative Council.


11 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 15<sup>TH</sup>  
12 day of JULY, 2022 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,218.0 FOR; -0-  
13 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by,  
14 Article VI, Section 1(d) (2) and (3) Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the  
15 Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant  
16 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June  
17 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).


