8		FY 2021-2024 Tribal Transportation Improvement Plan (TTIP), which included
9		PIR Road Maintenance 3, by Resolution No. 21-214; and
10	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Nation ("Nation") was notified of Grant (Contract) No.
11		A22AV00595, Papago Indian Reservation (PIR) Road Maintenance 3 in the amount
12	,	of \$17,624.69 from the U.S. Bureau of Indian Affairs ("BIA"), effective March 28,
13		2022 through August 31, 2024; and
14	WHEREAS,	the purpose of the grant is to provide financial assistance to the Nation for the
15		provision of all labor, materials, equipment and services necessary to perform
16		routine road maintenance activities on BIA Route 104 (Section 10), Route 193
17		(Section 10, 20, and 30), Route 195 (Section 20 and 30), Route 1003 (Section 10),
18		Route 1004 (Section 10) and Route 1005 (Section 10), identified as unpaved school
19		bus routes in Pima County, Arizona; and
20	WHEREAS,	the Planning and Economic Development Department, Roads Program, has
21		prepared and submitted for review and approval its FY 2022 PIR Road
22		Maintenance 3 Budget, which is incorporated by this reference, in the amount of
23		\$17,624.69; and
24	WHEREAS,	the Agricultural and Natural Resources and Budget and Finance Committees
25		have reviewed the Bureau of Indian Affairs Grant Award and the FY 2022 PIR Road
26		Maintenance 3 Budget and recommend their approval.
27	NOW, THER	EFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council accepts and
28		approves the Bureau of Indian Affairs Grant Award in the amount of \$17,624.69,
29		effective March 28, 2022 through August 31, 2024, for the purposes set forth herein
30		and, that shall be funded by the Nation's general fund pending reimbursement
31		from the grantor, the Bureau of Indian Affairs.
