

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY 2023 Department of Natural Resources Solid Waste Management
Program Revenue Funding Budget)**

RESOLUTION NO. 22-279

1 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds
2 within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to appropriate
3 these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll
4 expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"
5 authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham
6 Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and

7 **WHEREAS,** the Department of Health and Human Services has prepared and submitted for
8 review and approval its FY 2023 Solid Waste Management Program Revenue
9 Funding Budget, which is incorporated by this reference, in the amount of
10 \$2,435,264.93 of which \$1,835,264.93 is to be funded from the Nation's General
11 Fund; and, \$600,000.00 is to be funded by program revenues; and

12 **WHEREAS,** the portion of the FY 2023 Department of Natural Resources Solid Waste
13 Management Budget funded from the Nation's general fund is addressed by
14 separate resolution; and

15 **WHEREAS,** the Health and Human Services and Budget and Finance Committees have
16 reviewed the FY 2023 Department of Natural Resources Solid Waste Management
17 Program Revenue Funding Budget and recommend its approval.

18 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the
19 FY 2023 Department of Natural Resources Solid Waste Management Program
20 Revenue Funding Budget effective October 1, 2022, in the amount of \$600,000.00,
21 which shall be funded by program revenues.

22 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham
23 Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to administer and
24 expend the FY 2023 Department of Natural Resources Solid Waste Management
25 Program Revenue Funding Budget, provided that any amendments or
26 modifications shall be submitted for prior approval by the Tohono O'odham
27 Legislative Council.

28 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 09TH**
29 **day of AUGUST, 2022 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,218.0 FOR; -0-**
30 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by,**
31 **Article VI, Section 1(d)(2) and (3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by**
32 **the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
33 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
34 **18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**
