0		Nation's general fund pending reimbursement from the grantor, the EPA; and
1	WHEREAS,	the Water Resources and Budget and Finance Committees have reviewed the FY
2		2023 Water Resources Department EPA Budget and recommend its approval.
3	NOW, THER	EFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the
4		FY 2023 Water Resources Department Environmental Protection Agency Budget
5		effective October 1, 2022 in amount of \$135,000.00, which shall be funded by the
6		Nation's general fund pending reimbursement from grantor, the EPA.
7	BE IT FURT	THER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council authorizes the
8		Nation's chairperson or any designated official to seek reimbursement for
9		indirect cost expenses in the event an indirect cost rate is approved.

22		expend the FY 2023 Water Resources Department Environmental Protection
