

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Approving FY 2023 Tribal Employment Rights Commissioners Budget)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 22-298**

1 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds  
2 within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to appropriate  
3 these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll  
4 expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"  
5 authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham  
6 Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and

7 **WHEREAS,** the Tribal Employment Rights Commissioners has prepared and submitted for  
8 review and approval its FY 2023 Tribal Employment Rights Commissioners  
9 ("TERO Commissioners") Budget, which is incorporated by this reference, in the  
10 amount of \$126,003.36 to be funded from the TERO Commission Fees; and


11 **WHEREAS,** the Human Resources Development and Budget and Finance Committees have  
12 reviewed the FY 2023 Tribal Employment Rights Office Commissioner Budget and  
13 recommend its approval.

14 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the  
15 FY 2023 Tribal Employment Rights Commissioners Budget effective October 1,  
16 2022 in the amount of \$126,003.36 which shall be funded by the Tribal  
17 Employment Commission Fees.

18 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham  
19 Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to administer and  
20 expend the FY 2023 Tribal Employment Rights Commissioners Budget, provided  
21 that any amendments or modifications shall be submitted for prior approval by  
22 the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.

23 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 11<sup>TH</sup>  
24 day of AUGUST, 2022 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,218.0 FOR; -0-  
25 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by,  
26 Article VI, Section 1(d)(2) and (3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by  
27 the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant  
28 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June  
29 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
