1	WHEREAS,	the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation vests the Legislative Council with
2		the authority to "promote, protect and provide for public health, peace, morals,
3		education and general welfare of the Tohono O'odham Nation and its members"
4		(Constitution, Article VI, Section 1(c)(2)); and
5	WHEREAS,	the Indian Health Service ("IHS"), Division of Environmental Health and
6		Engineering conducts an annual assessment of Sanitation Facilities Deficiencies;
7		and
8	WHEREAS,	the Division of Environmental Health and Engineering assessment does have an
9		impact upon Congressional appropriations and IHS allocation of funds; and
10	WHEREAS,	the Indian Health Service has provided a Tribal Priority ranking of the three most
11		critical projects and allocated points, which impacts the overall prioritization of
12		projects; and
13	WHEREAS,	the Division of Environmental Health and Engineering has provided the
14		recommendations to the Health and Human Services Committee regarding the
15		most critical needs; and
16	WHEREAS,	the Health and Human Services Committee has reviewed and recommends
17	•	approval of the three most critical and desirable priorities.
18	NOW, THERI	FORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council has reviewed
19		and approved the entire priority list and has determined that the following
20		deficiencies are the three most critical and desirable, in descending order of
21		prioritization:
22		1. Meneger's Dam North Water Extension
23		2. Jackrabbit Water Main Upgrades
24		3. Little Tucson Main Replacements

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 13TH day of SEPTEMBER, 2022 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,218.0 FOR; <u>-0-</u> AGAINST; <u>-0-</u> NOT VOTING; and <u>-0-</u> ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by, Article VI, Section 1(c)(2) and 1(j) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
