

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Approving FY 2022-2023 Veteran's Affairs Office Supplemental Budget)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 22-325**

1 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds  
2 within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to appropriate  
3 these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll  
4 expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"  
5 authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham  
6 Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and

7 **WHEREAS,** the Veteran's Affairs Office has prepared and submitted for review and approval  
8 its FY 2022-2023 Veteran's Affairs Office Supplemental Budget, which is  
9 incorporated by this reference, in the amount of \$250,712.00 to be funded from  
10 the Nation's General Fund; and


11 **WHEREAS,** the Human Resources Development and Budget and Finance Committees have  
12 reviewed the FY 2022-2023 Veteran's Affairs Office Supplemental Budget and  
13 recommend its approval.

14 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the  
15 FY 2022-2023 Veteran's Affairs Office Supplemental Budget effective September  
16 1, 2022 ending September 30, 2023, in amount of \$250,712.00, which shall be  
17 funded by the Nation's General Fund.

18 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham  
19 Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to administer and  
20 expend the FY 2022-2023 Veteran's Affairs Office Supplemental Budget, provided  
21 that any amendments or modifications shall be submitted for prior approval by  
22 the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.

23 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 13<sup>TH</sup>**  
24 **day of SEPTEMBER, 2022 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,218.0 FOR;**  
25 **-0- AGAINST; [01] NOT VOTING; and -0- ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by,**  
26 **Article VI, Section 1(d)(2) and (3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by**  
27 **the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**  
28 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**  
29 **18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**




