7	WHEREAS,	the Department of Public Safety has prepared and submitted for review and
8		approval its FY 2023 Environmental Protection Office Brownfields Budget, which
9		is incorporated by this reference, in the amount of \$45,213.10 to be funded by the
10		Nation's general fund pending reimbursement from the U.S. Environmental
11		Protection Agency Assistance Agreement Grant under the Brownfields 128(a)
12		Tribal Response Program; and
13	WHEREAS,	the Department of Public Safety has received a no cost extension notice from U.S.
14		Environmental Protection Agency Assistance Agreement to extend until
15		September 30, 2023; and
16	WHEREAS,	the Domestic Affairs and Budget and Finance Committees have reviewed the
17		FY2023 Department of Public Safety Environmental Protection Office
18		Brownfields Budget and recommend its approval.
19	NOW, THERE	FORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the
20		FY 2023 Department of Public Safety Environmental Protection Office
21		Brownfields Program Budget effective October 1, 2022 in the amount of
22		\$45,213.10 which shall be funded by the Nation's general fund pending
23		reimbursement from the grantor, U.S. Environmental Protection Agency.

25		Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to administer and
26		expend the FY 2023 Department of Public Safety Environmental Protection Office

28		modifications shall be submitted for prior approval by the Tohono O'odham
29		Legislative Council.
