RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

(Amending Charter of the Community Development Financial Institution, Article V, Section 5.3.3.)

DEFEATED RESOLUTION NO. 22-383

1	WHEREAS,	the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation vests the Tohono O'odham
2		Legislative Council with the authority to "authorize, charter and regulate public
3		or private corporations and associations" and to "provide for, appoint, or provide
4		for the appointment of, and prescribe the duties and powers of committees,
5		boards, officers and agents" (Constitution, Article VI, Section 1(e) and 1(b)); and
6	WHEREAS,	by Resolution No. 04-103, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council adopted the
7		Charter of the Community Development Financial Institution of the Tohono
8		O'odham Nation (the "Charter"), establishing the Community Development
9		Financial Institution ("CDFI") as an enterprise of the Tohono O'odham Nation and
10		the CDFI Board of Directors ("CDFI Board") (Charter, 10 Tohono O'odham Code
11		Chapter 2); and
12	WHEREAS,	the Charter provides that the CDFI Board consists of five Directors who serve
13		staggered three-year terms and hold office until they are either reappointed, or
14	·	their successors are appointed and qualified (Charter, Article V, Sections 5.1.1.
15		and 5.1.6.); and
16	WHEREAS,	the Charter further provides that three Directors "shall constitute a quorum of
17		the Board for transaction of any business" (Charter, Article V, Section 5.3.3.); and
18	WHEREAS,	the CDFI Board currently has two Directors with expired terms who continue to
19		hold office until they are either reappointed or their successors are appointed
20		and qualified (Charter, Article V, Section 5.1.6.); and
21	WHEREAS,	with only two Directors, the CDFI Board cannot achieve a quorum to conduct
22		official business and oversee the operations and services provided by the CDFI to
23		the Tohono O'odham Nation's members; and
24	WHEREAS,	the Commerce Committee recommends temporarily amending the first sentence
25		of Section 5.3.3. of the Charter to adjust the CDFI Board quorum as follows:
26		5.3.3. Quorum; Board Action. The presence at any meeting of two (2) Directors
27		shall constitute a quorum of the Board for transaction of any business.
28	NOW, THERI	EFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council:
29		(1) amends the first sentence of Section 5.3.3. of the Charter of the Community
30		Development Financial Institution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, 10

10 11	The foregoing Resolution was defeated by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 14 TH day of <u>OCTOBER</u> , 2022 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 731.4 FOR;
