

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Nominating Tohono O'odham Nation Chairman Ned Norris, Jr. to the Department of  
Homeland Security's Tribal Homeland Security Advisory Council)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 22-385**

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is vested with the power "to promote,**  
2 **protect and provide for public health . . . and general welfare of the Tohono**  
3 **O'odham Nation and its members" and with the authority "to consult with the**  
4 **Congress of the United States and appropriate federal agencies regarding federal**  
5 **activities that affect the Tohono O'odham Nation" (Constitution, Article VI,**  
6 **Section 1(c)(2) and Section 1(j)); and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation also vests the Legislative Council**  
8 **with the authority to "consult, negotiate and conclude agreements and contracts**  
9 **on behalf of the Nation with Federal, State and local governments and other**  
10 **Indian tribes . . ." (Constitution, Article VI, Section 1(f)); and**

11 **WHEREAS, the Department of Homeland Security ("DHS") established the first-ever Tribal**  
12 **Homeland Security Advisory Council ("THSAC") which will enable tribal leaders to**  
13 **advise the Secretary on homeland security policies and practices that affect**  
14 **Indian Country and indigenous communities, including emergency**  
15 **management, law enforcement, cybersecurity, domestic terrorism and targeted**  
16 **violence, and border security; and**

17 **WHEREAS, THSAC will engage with DHS agencies and offices and produce recommendations**  
18 **and reports for the Secretary and will be charged with collaborating on all**  
19 **matters of homeland security as they relate to tribal nations and indigenous**  
20 **communities; and**

21 **WHEREAS, the THSAC'S membership will be diverse in its leadership, professional**  
22 **backgrounds, technical expertise, and geographic makeup; and**

23 **WHEREAS, DHS strives to establish a THSAC membership that is reflective of the wide**  
24 **expanse of Indian Country; and**

25 **WHEREAS, the Border Security Delegation and Domestic Affairs Committee recommend**  
26 **nominating Tohono O'odham Nation Chairman Ned Norris, Jr. for membership in**  
27 **the Department of Homeland Security's Tribal Homeland Security Advisory**  
28 **Council.**

29 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council nominates**  
30 **Tohono O'odham Nation Chairman Ned Norris, Jr. for membership in the**  
31 **Department of Homeland Security's Tribal Homeland Security Advisory Council.**

1 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the nomination**  
2 **made pursuant to this resolution shall immediately expire if the individual no**  
3 **longer continues to serve as an elected official of the Tohono O'odham Nation;**  
4 **provided that the Nation will seek to have the then-current chairperson of the**  
5 **Nation appointed to the Department of Homeland Security's Tribal Homeland**  
6 **Security Advisory Council.**

7 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 14<sup>TH</sup>**  
8 **day of OCTOBER, 2022 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,218,0 FOR;**  
9 **-0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by,**  
10 **Article VI, Section 1(b), Section 1(c)(2), Section 1(j) and Section 1(f) of the Constitution of the**  
11 **Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and**  
12 **approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6,**  
13 **1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**
