13		mobile event wagering in the State of Arizona as the Nation's fully owned event
14		wagering operator; and
15	WHEREAS,	by Resolution No. 21-256, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approved the
16		Desert Diamond Mobile LLC Limited Liability Company Agreement (the
17		"Agreement"); and
18	WHEREAS,	the Commerce Committee and Nation's chairman recommend amending Section
19		5 of the Agreement in accordance with the "October 2022 Amendment," which is
20		incorporated by this reference, to address the composition, appointment, and
21		qualifications of the Board of Managers; and
22	WHEREAS,	it is in the Nation's best interest to approve the October 2022 Amendment.
