Additionally, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council authorizes participation in the "Identifying Our Needs: A Survey of Elders" needs assessment and grants permission to the National Resource Center on Native American Aging to use all collected needs assessment information in an aggregate format for disseminating state, regional, and national results from analyses of the data.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that specific information collected within the boundaries of the Tohono O'odham Nation belongs to the Tohono O'odham Nation and may not be released in any form to individuals, agencies or organizations without tribal authorization.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to execute the Application for Elder Services Funding from the Administration for Community Living/Administration on Aging Older Americans Act Title VI Nutrition, Supportive Service and Caregiver Grants (Part A/B and C) and Participation in the Cycle VIII of the National Resource Center on Native American Aging Needs Assessment "Identifying Our Needs: A Survey of Elders" substantially in the form attached hereto provided that any amendments shall be submitted for prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.
