

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Approving FY 2023 Radio Use Agreement between the Tohono O'odham  
Nation and Drexel Heights Fire District)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 22-409**

1 **WHEREAS, the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation vests the Legislative Council with**  
2 **the power "to promote, protect, and provide for . . . general welfare of the Tohono**  
3 **O'odham Nation and its members" and "[t]o consult, negotiate and conclude**  
4 **agreements and contracts on behalf of the Tohono O'odham Nation with Federal,**  
5 **State and local governments . . . on all matters within the authority of the Tohono**  
6 **O'odham Council." (Constitution, Article VI, Section 1(c)(2) and Section 1(f)); and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Fire Department has submitted for review and**  
8 **approval the FY 2023 Radio Use Agreement between the Tohono O'odham Nation**  
9 **and Drexel Heights Fire District, which is incorporated by this reference, for the**  
10 **period October 1, 2022 to September 30, 2023; and**


11 **WHEREAS, the FY 2023 Radio Use Agreement will allow Drexel Heights Fire District to act as**  
12 **billing administrator for the Nation's use of PCWIN radio equipment in San**  
13 **Xavier District; and**

14 **WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs Committee has reviewed the Radio Use Agreement and**  
15 **recommends its approval.**

16 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**  
17 **FY 2023 Radio Use Agreement between the Tohono O'odham Nation and Drexel**  
18 **Heights Fire District substantially in the form attached.**

19 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 17<sup>TH</sup>**  
20 **day of NOVEMBER, 2022 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,218.0 FOR;**  
21 **~~-0-~~ AGAINST; ~~-0-~~ NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by,**  
22 **Article VI, Section 1(f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**  
23 **O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**  
24 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934**  
25 **(48 Stat.984).**




