5		authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham
6		Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and
7	WHEREAS,	the FY 2019 Executive Branch Vehicle Replacement Program Budget in the
8		amount of \$4,872,698.51 was approved by Resolution No. 19-165 and authorized
9		that the remaining unexpended funds shall be carried forward to complete the
10		vehicle replacement program; and
11	WHEREAS,	by Resolution No. 20-348 budget was increased by \$175,254.00 from \$4,872,698.51
12		to \$5,047,952.51 and by Resolution No. 21-440 Budget Authority was extended into
13		FY 2022; and
14	WHEREAS,	the budget authority expired on September 30, 2022 which makes it necessary to
15		extend the budget authority into FY 2023; and
16	WHEREAS,	the Executive Branch has submitted for review and approval its request to amend
17		Resolution No. 21-440 to extend the budget into FY 2023 to allow for all available
18		funds to be expended; and
19	WHEREAS,	the Budget and Finance Committee has reviewed this resolution and recommend
20		its approval.
21	NOW, THERE	FORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council amends
22		Resolution No. 21-440 to extend the budget authority for FY 2023 and that the
23		remaining unexpended funds shall be carried forward to complete the vehicle
24		replacement program.
25	BE IT FINALL	Y RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham
26		Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to administer and
27		expend these funds for the period of October 1, 2022 through September 30, 2023
28		and the Accounting Office is authorized to post the unexpended balances of the
29		budget as of September 30, 2022 as a carry forward in the FY 2023 beginning
30		October 1, 2022, provided that any amendments or modifications shall be
31		submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.
