## RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL (Affirming the Tohono O'odham Nation's Health Care State Legislation Positions)

RESOLUTION NO. 23-032

1	WHEREAS,	the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation vests the Legislative Council with
2		the authority to "promote, protect and provide for public health, peace, morals,
3	Ì	education and general welfare of the Tohono O'odham Nation and its members"
4		and to "consult, negotiate and conclude agreements and contracts on behalf of
5		the Tohono O'odham Nation with Federal, State and local governments"
6		(Constitution, Article VI, Section 1(c)(2) and Section 1(f)); and
7	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Nation has taken positions in support of and in opposition
8		to proposed state health care legislation (e.g. Resolution No. 19-053 "Supporting
9		Arizona Senate Bill 1134," Resolution No. 22-114 "Supporting Arizona House and
10		Senate Health Bills"); and
11	WHEREAS,	in order to effectively advocate for state health care legislation that benefits the
12		Nation and its members and to oppose state legislation that may limit access to,
13		or cut funding for, important health care services, the Appropriations and Health
14	9	and Human Services Committees recommend affirming the Nation's health care
15		state legislation positions.
16	NOW, THERI	FORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council affirms
17		Resolution Nos. 19-053 and 22-114, and its prior positions on the substance of the
18		Tohono O'odham Nation's state health care legislation, by continuing to support
19		legislation that:
20		(1) expands Nation's members' access to health care, including dental care;
21		(2) increases funding for health care services, including Arizona's Medicaid;
22		(3) increases funding for drug abuse prevention, treatment, and mental
23		health services;
24		(4) expands Kidscare eligibility; and
25		(5) expands tribal access to health care resources.
26	BE IT FINALI	Y RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council opposes state health
27		care legislation that limits funding, access to, or eligibility for health care
