

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY 2023 Department of Public Safety Environmental Protection Office
Brownfields Program Budget Amendment No. 1)

RESOLUTION NO. 23-058

1 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds
2 within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to appropriate
3 these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll
4 expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"
5 authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham
6 Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and

7 **WHEREAS,** the FY 2023 Department of Public Safety Environmental Protection Office ("EPO")
8 Brownfields Program Budget in the amount of \$45,213.10 was approved by
9 Resolution No. 22-358 ; and

10 **WHEREAS,** the Department of Public Safety has prepared and submitted for review and
11 approval its FY 2023 EPO Brownfields Program Budget Amendment No. 1, which
12 is incorporated by this reference and which will adjust operational and/or
13 personnel line items; and

14 **WHEREAS,** the FY 2023 Department of Public Safety EPO Brownfields Program Budget
15 Amendment No. 1 will increase by \$ 59,417.84, from \$45,213.10 to \$ 104,630.94; and

16 **WHEREAS,** the Domestic Affairs and Budget and Finance Committees have reviewed the FY
17 2023 Department of Public Safety EPO Brownfields Program Budget Amendment
18 No. 1 and recommend its approval.

19 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the
20 FY 2023 Department of Public Safety Environmental Protection Office
21 Brownfields Program Budget Amendment No. 1, which includes an increase of
22 \$59,417.84, from \$ 45,213.10 to \$ 104,630.94.

23 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham
24 Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to administer and
25 expend the FY 2023 Department of Public Safety Environmental Protection Office
26 Brownfields Program Budget as amended, provided that any amendments or
27 modifications shall be submitted for prior approval by the Tohono O'odham
28 Legislative Council.
